	Morning	Arrive in Bologna.
NOTES	9.30 - 10.15 AM	Piazza Maggiore, Piazza delle Nettuno & Biblioteca Salaborsa (library) The piazzas are next to each other, see Neptune's Fountain and Roman excavations under Biblioteca Salaborsa - open to the public.
NOTES	10.20 - 11.00 PM	<a href="#">Basilica di San Petronia</a>
NOTES	11.00 - 12.00 PM	Climb <a href="#">Asinelli Tower</a> If you don't feel like climbing the 498 steps, grab a gelato instead or visit the <a href="#">Anatomical Theatre</a> built in the 1600's as part of the University
NOTES	12.30 - 1.30 PM	Explore <a href="#">Mercato di Mezzo</a>
NOTES	1.30- 2.30 PM	Explore the Quadrilatero, the old market quarter

NOTES	2.45 - 4.30 PM	Take the <a href="#">San Luca Express</a> to Basilica of San Lucca For gorgeous views over Bologna and the countryside
	4.45 - 5.30 PM	Cattedrale Metropolitana di San Pietro This is the Duomo of Bologna a five minute walk from Piazza Maggiore
NOTES	6.00 - ONWARDS	Enjoy an aperitivo at <a href="#">Mercato delle Erbe</a> Then enjoy dinner at one of the many restaurants in Bologna, known for it's wonderful food.
